Bikes and Brews

This itinerary highlights attractions and breweries along Muskegon Lake, White Lake, and Lake Michigan. If you're a motorcycle enthusiast looking for a scenic tour with an abundance of fun and fascinating stops along the way, you're going to love Muskegon County!

Day 1

Start the day with a tour of the **USS LST 393 Veterans Museum**, one of only two Landing Ship Tanks from WWII that remain in existence in the United States. www.lst393.org

Next, take a 5-mile ride through the historic Lakeside District to our beautiful public beach at **Pere Marquette Park!** There you'll find the **USS Silversides Submarine Museum**, featuring a World War II submarine, a 1927 Coast Guard Cutter, and an outstanding naval museum. www.silversideseuseum.org

Have lunch on the beach at Muskegon's new barbeque restaurant, **The Deck**, or try **Docker's Fish House**. Docker's specialize in seafood and also offers a full menu of steaks, gourmet salads, sandwiches and a full bar! www.dockersfishhouse.com

With two new craft breweries downtown and one in Whitehall, Muskegon County is rapidly becoming a craft brew lover's paradise!

Check out **Pigeon Hill Brewing Company** located in the downtown historic district on Muskegon Lake. www.pigeonhillbrew.com

Just up Western Avenue is **Unruly Brewing Company**, the first brewery to brew beer in Muskegon since 1957. They offer a wide range of craft beer styles as well as an outdoor beer garden, live music, and free brewery tours anytime! www.unrulybrewing.com

As you enjoy exploring the craft brewing scene in Muskegon, be sure to check out all of our great downtown attractions:

- **The Hackley & Hume Historic Site** – Completely restored 19th Century Victorian homes. www.lakeshoremuseum.org
- **The Lakeshore Museum Center** showcases natural and cultural history of Muskegon County. www.lakeshoremuseum.org

- **Muskegon Museum of Art** - One of the most highly respected art museums in the Midwest. www.muskegonartmuseum.org

- **Hot Rod Harley Davidson** - 40,000 sq. ft. facility with a full line of Harley-Davidson motorcycles, parts and accessories.
- **Port City Princess** – Themed cruises on Muskegon Lake and Lake Michigan. www.portcityprincesscruises.com
- **Scolnik House of the Depression Era & Fire Barn Museum** - Walk through how common families lived during the Great Depression. Then enjoy a reproduction of C. H. Hackley Hose Company No. 2 right next door. www.lakeshoremuseum.org



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Day 2

Take a 20-mile, picturesque tour up Scenic Drive to the White Lake Area! Along the way, you'll enjoy spectacular views of Lake Michigan as you travel this winding, sun-dappled road that leads past state and county parks like **Muskegon State Park**, the **Winter Sports Complex**, the **Block House**, **Pioneer County Park**, and **Duck Lake State Park**!

Be sure to check out the newest brewery, **Fetch Brewing** in Whitehall! This 6,000 square-foot space has a full bar, two levels of table space

and a vault that has been transformed into a seating area known as the "Penny Lounge", as its floor is made entirely of pennies. They feature seven beers ranging from 3.5 to 6 percent. www.fetchbrewing.com

Once you arrive in the White Lake Area, you'll discover historic attractions and unique shopping opportunities in a small town with an artsy vibe.

- **Michigan's Heritage Park at Hilt's Landing** - Living history park exploring 10,000 years of Michigan history in a natural woodland setting. www.lakeshoremuseum.org
- **The White River Light Station** - Lighthouse museum. www.whiteriverlightstation.org
- **The World's Largest Weathervane** - 48-feet tall with an arrow 26-feet long. www.whitelake.org
